

SCIENCE COMMITTEE

TERMS OF REFERENCE FEBRUARY 19, 2018

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP

- 1. The committee is a standing committee of the Canadian Organization of Medical Physicists (COMP).
- 2. The Chair of the committee is a member of the COMP Board.
- 3. The chair will present a written report to the COMP Board prior to each inperson Board meeting and the Annual General Meeting of COMP.

PURPOSE

The Committee will:

1. promote and support the science of medical physics, for those within the profession.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- 1. To coordinate and organize the work of COMP in respect to issues regarding scientific activities of medical physicists in Canada
- 2. To report regularly to the COMP Board, including a biannual report and presentation of recommendations and an annual budget for approval
- 3. To coordinate activities with other organizations of similar interests.
- 4. To develop and monitor relations with governmental science and funding agencies
- 5. To oversee the organization of the Annual Scientific Meeting.

MEMBERSHIP

The Committee is composed of:

- 1. a chair who is approved by the COMP Board for a term of three years;
- 2. the COMP Board vice-president;
- 3. the chair of the Annual Scientific Meeting
- 4. the scientific chair of the Annual Scientific Meeting
- 5. the Grants and Funding liaison
- 6. other members as required

RULES OF ORDER

- 1. The committee should meet a minimum of two times a year, either by teleconference or in person.
- 2. A quorum consists of the committee chair and at least three other members.
- 3. Summary minutes of meetings will be taken and all decisions shall be recorded.
- 4. The committee should function as far as possible by consensus, otherwise a majority decision will be respected. The chair shall have the deciding vote in the case of a tie. Recommendations to the COMP Board may also include a minority opinion.

BUDGET

An annual budget for the committee will be prepared and submitted to the COMP Treasurer.
